Birth through PreK instructional personnel (public or private), including but not limited to:

- Teachers
- Program Directors
- Interventionists
- Instructional Coaches

WHY?

- Build literacy knowledge and skills with high-quality content
- A completion stipend is available for VPK and early learning instructional personnel

WHEN?

- Enrollment opens December 31, 2022
- Can be completed in less than six months

HOW?

A hybrid model of online modules, instructor-led courses, and job-embedded practicum:

- Component 2: Emergent Literacy Modules: 20 hours
- Component 3: Practicum: 20 hours

COMPETENCY-BASED MICRO-CREDENTIAL

The literacy micro-credentials provide educators with evidence-based, high-quality online courses to build their literacy knowledge and skills. Through a job-embedded practicum, participants will implement their new instructional strategies in real-time while receiving one-on-one feedback from assessors to refine, enhance, and improve their literacy practice.

IMPACTING EVERY LEVEL OF THE EDUCATION SYSTEM

EMERGENT

- Birth through PreK instructional personnel (public or private)
- A completion stipend is available for VPK and early learning instructional personnel
- Supports language and literacy requirements for the CDA professional portfolio

ELEMENTARY

- PreK (public or private) and kindergarten through fifth grade (public) instructional personnel
- Allows instructional personnel who are not reading endorsed or certified in reading to teach intensive reading intervention, if supervised by an individual who is certified or endorsed in reading
- Satisfies Competency 1 of the Reading Endorsement

SECONDARY

- Sixth through twelfth grade instructional personnel
- Allows instructional personnel who are not reading endorsed or certified in reading to teach intensive reading intervention, if supervised by an individual who is certified or endorsed in reading
- Satisfies Competency 1 of the Reading Endorsement
