






The Elementary Literacy Micro-Credential prepares elementary instructional personnel to identify literacy needs, apply evidence-based practices, and engage in effective progress monitoring and intervention.



WHO SHOULD PARTICIPATE?

PreK (public or private) and kindergarten through fifth grade instructional personnel (public schools, including charters)

WHY?

- → \$2,000 completion stipend for *eligible child care personnel and early learning instructional staff (public or private)
- → \$1,000 completion stipend for *eligible K-12 instructional personnel (public schools, including charters)
- → Allows instructional personnel to teach intensive reading intervention, if supervised by an individual who is certified or endorsed in reading
- → Satisfies Competency 1 of the Reading Endorsement
- → Earn 60 inservice hours/6.0 CEUs
- → Satisfies the 40-hour reading requirement for renewal
- → Learn to analyze grade-level FAST progress monitoring data

HOW?

A hybrid model of online courses and instructor-supported online practicum:

- → Component 1: Foundations of Literacy Science of Reading
- → Component 2: Instructional Practice
- → Component 3: Instructor Supported Practicum

Recommended completion time: 10 weeks
