WHAT?

 - Day 2: 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- → K-5 classroom teachers in Florida's public schools, including public charter schools.
- > VPK lead teachers and aides who work at a VPK contracted provider.

WHERE?

- → Sessions are scheduled in counties across the state and organized into VPK-K, 1-2, and 3-5 grade bands.
- → Each school district, including charter schools and lab schools, has been assigned a regional location. See back page.
